**Rules and Regulations:**

- Park in designated student parking only.
- Display parking permit on rearview mirror. Permits must be visible.
- Parking will be enforced by the City of Mountain View. MVHS does not issue tickets, collect revenue or excuse tickets.
- Cars may be cited by MVPD or towed for abuse of the parking permit privilege, parking without a valid permit.
- Permit parking is limited to seniors, juniors and sophomores with valid parking permits.
- Permits are issued to the student and vehicle and are NOT transferable to other students or vehicles. If a vehicle is sold or changed during the school year a new parking contract must be signed.
- If lost or stolen a new permit must be purchased.
- Only one permit will be issued to a family with multiple students.
- Obey all traffic laws.
- Drive 10 mph in the parking lot.
- Use trash receptacles for garbage.
- Do not park in red zones, fire lanes, visitor or staff parking.

*Student parking is a privilege and may be revoked at any time without refund for the following reasons:*

- Truancy
- Excessive Tardies
- Abuse of parking privileges, rules and regulations
- Dangerous or reckless driving
- Violation of MVHS student code of conduct contract

## STUDENT PARKING PERMITS 2019-2020

All vehicles must have a current parking permit to park on school grounds.

- Visitors must obtain a temporary permit to park on school grounds.
- In order to obtain a permit, students must complete the Student Parking Contract. This contract must be signed by the student's parent or guardian. Return the signed contract with a valid driver's license (provisional permits are not accepted), current registration and current car insurance, cash or a check, money order made out to MVHS for \$40.00.
- **Permit Parking Contracts will be available on the MVHS website on Aug. 1, to print and fill out.**
- **If purchased online print and bring payment receipt to the Finance office.**
- **Parking Permits will not be sold to any students with outstanding fees.**

*You must bring:*

- *Current California driver's license, current vehicle registration and current car insurance.*
- *Cash, check or money order for \$40.00 payable to MVHS*
- *Completed contract signed by student and parent*
- *Current Student ID Card (available on the following days)*
  - *Seniors, August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2:00pm – 3:30 pm*
  - *Juniors, August 13<sup>th</sup>, 10:30 am – 12:00 pm*
  - *Sophomores, August 13<sup>th</sup>, 8:00 am – 9:30 am*

### RULES AND REGULATIONS
